There will be only one final winner chosen from the three finalists on the day of the festival May 16, 2010. That winner will receive a \$1000 cash prize courtesy of Eco-Consulting. The final winner will be announced and will receive the prize on the Main stage of the festival. The winner and/or finalists might also be granted an interview with Eco Consulting for a potential internship position. However, there is no guarantee that the interview will result in an internship position being offered.

The finalists must agree to be filmed and participate in any PR and media relations associated with the WorldFest Design Contest, WorldFest Festival and Eco Consulting.

Whereas no fee or purchase is required to enter the first round of the contest, the chosen finalists who make it to the second round are financially responsible to produce and transport their design concept for the 2010 WorldFest.

WorldFest is a festival produced by the 501c3 nonprofit 'Towards Freedom'. Wherever the term WorldFest is used in these guidelines, it is an all-inclusive reference to the nonprofit organization 'Towards Freedom' and understood to signify 'Towards Freedom' the nonprofit organization as opposed to the festival (WorldFest) as a legal entity.

## **Submission Period**

Submissions will be accepted anytime before and including May 2 by emailing a signed and completed WorldFest Design Competition Submission form to [design@worldfestevents.com](mailto:design@worldfestevents.com)

## **Additional Requirements**

Submissions should be primarily in English. The person whose name appears on the submission form as the contestant will be deemed the entrant ("Entrant"). The Entrant is the one (1) person who is listed and owns the email address in the application. If any group elects to collaborate on a Submission, they are required to designate one (1) person as the agent of the group to enter the Contest, agree to these rules and accept the prize on behalf of the group. Neither WorldFest and Eco Consulting nor any of the Contest Parties are liable for any disputes between collaborators arising under or related to the Contest.

Each individual Entrant is allowed a total of one (1) Submission during the submission period. Each Submission must comply with these Rules.

Each Submission must be the original work of the Entrant produced for this Contest; it may not have been entered in or won previous contests or awards; it may not have been published previously in any medium; it must not infringe any party's intellectual property or other rights; it must not contain obscene or pornographic material; it must not include threats to any person, place, business, group or world peace; it must not invade privacy or other rights of any person, firm or entity, and it must not in any other way violate applicable laws and

regulations.

Each Submission must not contain any copyrighted works (other than those owned by the Entrant).

By submitting the designs, the contestant fully and unconditionally agrees to and accepts these rules. This contest adheres to the CALIFORNIA RULES FOR OPERATION OF CONTESTS (Business and Professions Code sections 17539-17539.3, 17539.35) and is void outside the jurisdiction of the state of California.

WorldFest and Eco Consulting reserves the right to, without prior notice and at any time, terminate or cancel the contest, in whole or in part, or modify the contest in any way. WorldFest and Eco Consulting is not accountable for (i) any events beyond its control that may cause the contest to be interrupted or corrupted; (ii) any injuries, losses, or damages of any kind occurring with or as a result of the prize, or from participation in the contest. In the case of severe weather, part or all of WorldFest may be shut down. In this case the contest may have to be cancelled.
